



Uganda Inter-Schools Golf Championship 2025

Format for School Teams and Scoring Calculation for Players

Format for School Teams:

1. Team Composition:

- Each participating school can register a team consisting of up to 12 boys and 12 girls.
- Teams will be paired with teams from other schools and will play either as 3 balls or 4 balls.
- To qualify under the schools category, each school must have at least 4 players representing the school.

2. Age Categories and Competition Format:

- **Primary/Junior Schools (Ages 10 and below):** 9-hole stroke play competition.
- **High Schools (Ages 11-20):** 18-hole stroke play competition.
- **New Golfers Category:** Special category for new golfers who play 9 holes only, also under the stroke play format.

3. Gender Categories:

- **Boys and Girls:** Separate categories for boys and girls within each age group.
- **Overall Best Performing Schools:** The top 3 performing schools will be recognized based on the day's performance across all different competitions.

Tournament Format:

- The championship will follow a stroke play format.
- Each student will play the specified number of holes based on their age category.
- Individual scores will also count towards individual winners in each category.

Scoring Calculation:

1. Individual Scoring:

- Each student's score is calculated based on the total number of strokes taken to complete the specified number of holes.
- The lower the number of strokes, the better the score.

2. Team Scoring:

- The team score is determined by summing the best 4 scores from each school's team.
- The team with the lowest total score wins the championship.

3. Tie-Breaker:

- In the event of a tie, the team with the lowest individual score among the top 4 players will be declared the winner.



- If the tie persists, the next lowest individual score will be considered, and so on.

Overall Best Performing Schools:

- The top 3 performing schools will be recognized based on the day's performance across all different competitions.
- This includes the best performances from both boys and girls categories within the Primary/Junior Schools and High Schools.

Additional Information:

- **Practice Rounds:** Each team will have access to practice rounds at the designated training venues prior to the championship.
- **Coaching and Support:** Expert coaches will be available to provide guidance and support during practice sessions.
- **Equipment:** All necessary golfing equipment will be provided during the tournament.
